

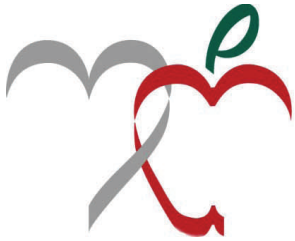

A. "Turn Their Lights On! Sizzling Hands-On Lessons and Skills for Student Success!" with Starla Ewan

Participants will experience and participate in many 'hands-on' lessons that turn difficult concepts and materials into a 'WOW! I GET IT' moment for students. These activities are 'ready to go' and are a proven success in the classroom. Teachers will have fun adding these to their curriculum and making their lessons a sizzling success for their students!



B. Creating Quality Assessment Items with Kim Smith

This workshop is about writing effective test items and developing assessments that health science teachers can use in their classrooms. The main focus will be on evaluating and constructing multiple choice items, although other item types will be addressed. After learning how to evaluate and write effective test items, workshop participants will get plenty of practice with their new skills as they write items for the NCHSE Curriculum Supplements. As a bonus, all participants will receive an edited set of the test items developed as a part of this work shop. The goal is to help health science teachers understand the concepts, principles and procedures available to construct quality test items that will lead to effective classroom assessment.

C. Travel by bus to Rochester, Minnesota and spend a day at the world renowned Mayo Clinic.

Mayo Clinic is the first and largest integrated, not-for-profit group practice in the world. Doctors from every medical specialty work together to care for patients, joined by common systems and a philosophy of "the needs of the patient come first." More than 3,300 physicians, scientists and researchers and 46,000 allied health staff work at Mayo Clinic. The day will include a tour of the Rochester Mayo campus, the multidisciplinary Simulation Center and presentations on the Mayo model of education (patient care, medical research and academic education). Each participant will have the opportunity to do a guided field experience in at least one clinical specialty area. Space is limited for this pre-conference session.
