GROWING EXCELLENCE and ENHANCING LEADERSHIP



Institute for Educational Excellence (IEE) is a two and a half-day intensive training for a select group of innovative health science teachers. IEE will focus on the National Health Science Standards, bringing industry to the classroom, student engagement, pedagogy, technology, and STEM. Participants will be selected after completing an application process, which includes a recommendation from the health science state leader and a school administrator. Two participants will be chosen from each state with two named alternates. **The registration fee for the institute is \$500 for selected participants from member states. Registration for individuals from nonmember states is \$650.** Breakfast is provided by the hotel and lunch is included with registration costs. Dinner, travel and lodging will be the responsibility of the participant. Each elite teacher will receive a copy of the new health science curriculum enhancements (2016), a \$300 value and will be trained to and expected to redeliver acquired information in their home states. Institute for Educational Excellence participants will be invited to present at the 2018 National Health Science Curriculum Conference (Denver, CO). Teachers completing the Institute for Educational Excellence will receive a NCHSE Health Science Institute for Educational Excellence certificate.

- Experiencing the power of working with growth-focused, motivated, like-minded peers.
- Learning strategies to motivate and inspire other health science teachers through school, district, and state leadership.
- Designing “hooks” to stimulate topic interest, show subject relevance, and arouse curiosity.
- Identifying factors that a teacher can control to improve instruction and student learning.
- Applying guidelines for effective classroom functioning to create a productive learning environment and to work with different student behaviors.
- Receiving training on how to utilize the National Health Science Standards in your curriculum.
