

2020 National Health Science Virtual Conference FAQ's

What is meant by a Virtual Conference?

The 2020 National Health Science Conference sessions will be conducted online through a virtual platform that will capture all the conference content. This alternative solution will provide an engaging, accessible, and inclusive platform to convene our health science teachers, administrators, and health science state leaders.

*The five-day program will include sessions that can be viewed as they are streamed or viewed on demand **for 30 days from the day the conference begins** on October 27.*

Is there a cut-off date for registration?

***October 20** is the cut-off date for registration. Having a cut-off date is necessary so each attendee can be set-up with a personal username and password prior to the start of the conference. If an attendee is added after October 20, there will be a 48-hour delay before a new attendee can be added to the platform and given their access code.*

How long will Conference content be available?

*All conference content will be available for **30 days** from the start of the conference. The last day to view all other conference content will be November 25th.*

How do I access the conference?

You will receive an email with your conference ID and code to gain access to the conference content.

When will I receive my conference ID and code?

The conference team will email your conference ID and code 2 days prior to the beginning of the conference.

When I login to the conference will I be on video?

When you login to the conference platform to participate in the LIVE general and networking sessions, you will be on video if you have your camera on. . When you log into zoom for breakout sessions, you can choose whether to have your camera on or off.

What if I miss a live session?

*All the sessions will be recorded. All sessions can be viewed 48 hours after they are streamed. **All content will be available for 30 days.***

Will Q & A sessions be recorded?

Yes, Q&A sessions will be recorded and posted with the presenter's session recording 48 hours after the conference presentation.

What if I have technical issues?

There will be a virtual concierge available during the live conference hours to answer questions related to accessing the conference platform.

What if I have technical issues after the conference during the 30 day that they material are available?

How do I ask questions of the speakers?

Live Q&A sessions will be hosted with the keynote speakers only, these sessions will take place after their workshop presentations. See agenda for dates and times.
